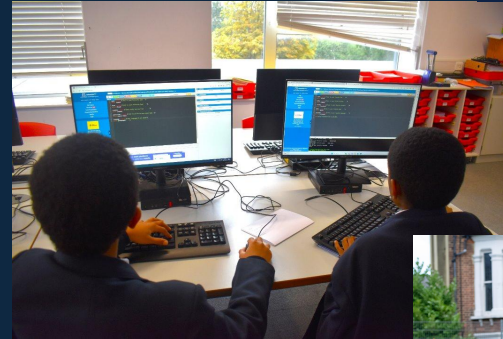

Furthermore, we support our families with the purchase of new uniform. We offer a free blazer, tie and backpack to all Year 7 students.



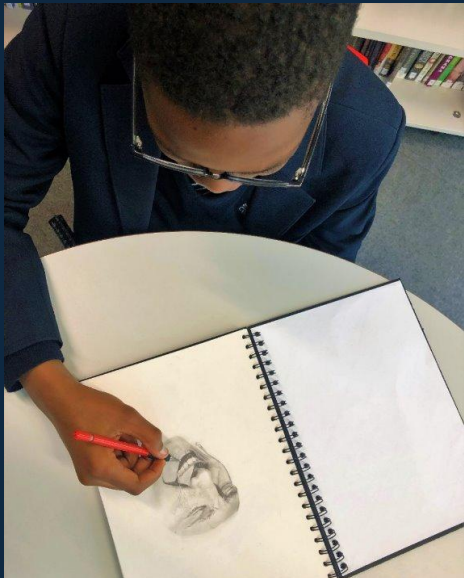
