Results

GCSE Results

- Progress 8 score: +0.4 (top 15% of schools)
- Significantly above national averages for attainment:
 - 15% students achieved a grade 7+ (A/A*) in five or more GCSEs (incl. English and Maths)
 - 70% students achieved a grade 4+ (C+) in five or more GCSEs (incl. English and Maths)
- Outstanding EBacc results in Science, Languages and Humanities

A-level results well above national averages

- 35% of students went to Russell Group Universities including 2 students who went to Oxbridge.
- Students went on to Apprenticeships, Art Foundation courses, international universities.

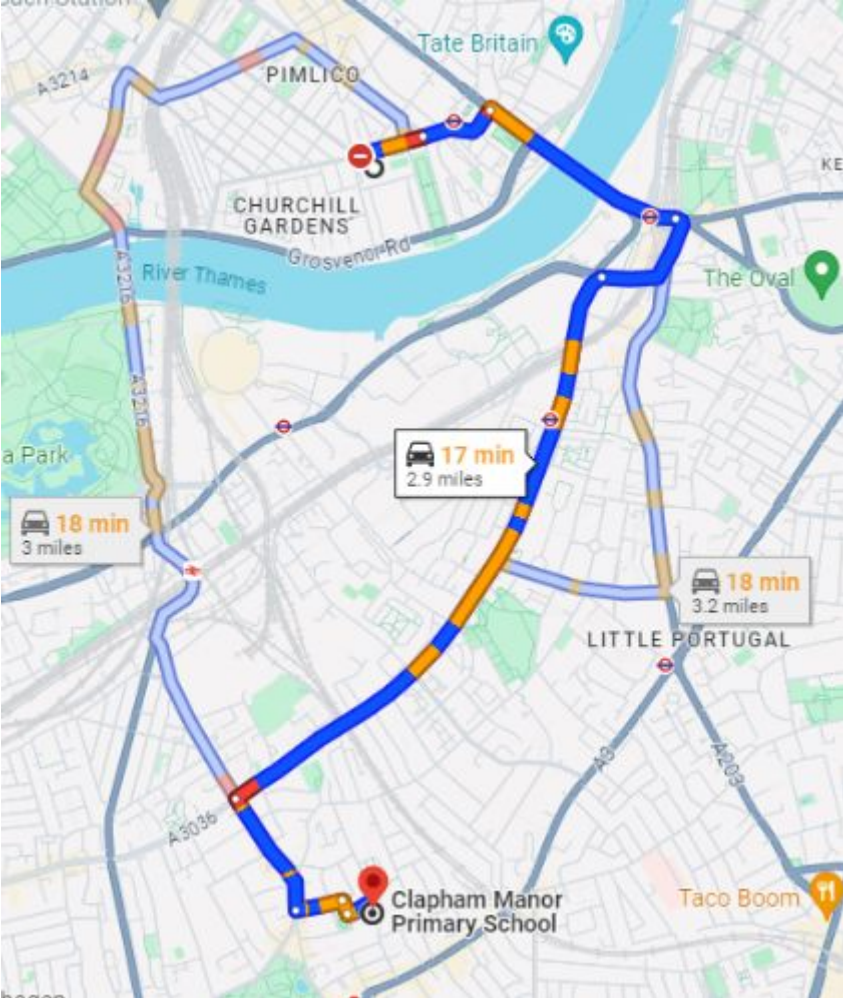
