We are excited to announce that Choir Club will be run by our new Music teacher, Mr George! This club can admit a total of 45 pupils and sessions will be supported by a teaching assistant.

Once your child is registered with the club, they will automatically be enrolled into the club for the remainder of the academic year. There will be no need to sign your child up again each term. However, positions will only be secured by making a payment of £25 **ahead** of each term, **totalling £75 over the year**. If payments are not made, we will presume your child no longer wishes to attend Choir Club and available spaces will be communicated to other parents / carers who may want their child to join.

If your child would like to sign up for the year, we highly recommend they sign up in Autumn term as spaces across other terms may not be available. A payment plan for a child signing up to a whole year will look like the following:

- **Summer term 2025:** £25 for signing up to Autumn 25 Choir Club
- **Autumn term 2025:** £25 for signing up to Spring 26 Choir Club
- **Spring term 2026:** £25 for signing up to Summer 26 Choir Club

You are also able to pay the £75 in one go and register your children for the year. Refunds will not be possible.

Parents support/volunteers

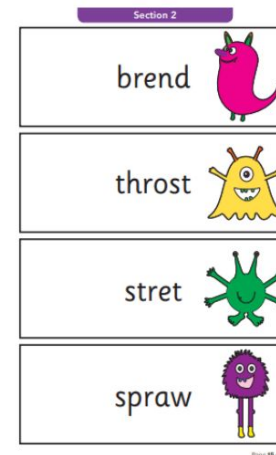
- We value the offer of support from parents in any way.

Statutory Assessments

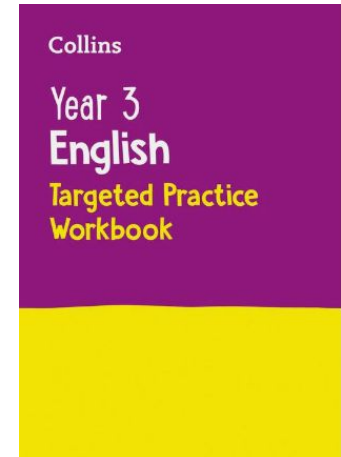
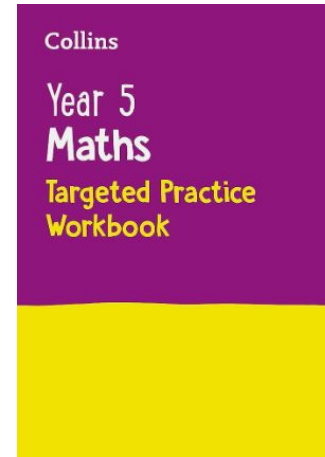
In Year 1, all children nationally complete the Phonics Screening Check in the summer term. This is a check of the children's knowledge of all the sounds they have learnt in phonics over their time in school so far and is delivered 1:1 with a teacher they know well.

Children learn phonics daily in their Read, Write Inc. phonics groups, where teacher's assess them regularly so we can ensure they are making good progress. We will share more information about the Phonics Screening Check, and ways you can support your child at home over the year ahead.



Home Learning

- Home Learning will be set weekly every **Friday** and collected in the following **Thursday**.
- We will continue to use Collins Targeted Practice Workbooks for English and Maths.
- Daily Fluency Practice must take place across **Numbots** (KS1) Reading and Spelling.
- Optional '**Half Termly Projects**' are also set where we encourage children to make one project relating to a topic they are being taught over that half term.

Both of these books will be at the same level (ie. if they are in the green phonics group, both of these books will be green band)

Contacting a member of staff

- We value face to face communication and ensure that class teachers are available before and after school.
- Although staff can be contacted by email, we ask that you are mindful of our teachers staff workload, as such we will operate an email window between **7am and 7pm, Monday to Friday**; emails will not be reviewed outside of these times.
- Our school's policy is to respond to all emails, where possible, within **3 working days**.

What your child will need



- Book bag with reading record & reading book.
- A named water bottle.
- Appropriate additional clothing, suitable for the weather (i.e. coat, hat, gloves).
- If it is necessary for your child to have a phone, these need to be turned off and handed in to a member of staff on the gate in the morning.
- At break, children can have a **healthy snack** of fresh fruit.
- **Milk** is available for the children who have been registered or have paid if they are over 5. Please make sure your child knows if they are / are not having milk.
- **Fruit** - we have a snack table and fruit will be provided.
- Please ensure that **nuts** are not included in packed lunches.
- Please ensure your child does not bring in any toys, stationary or personal items. It's important we are consistent across the whole school.
