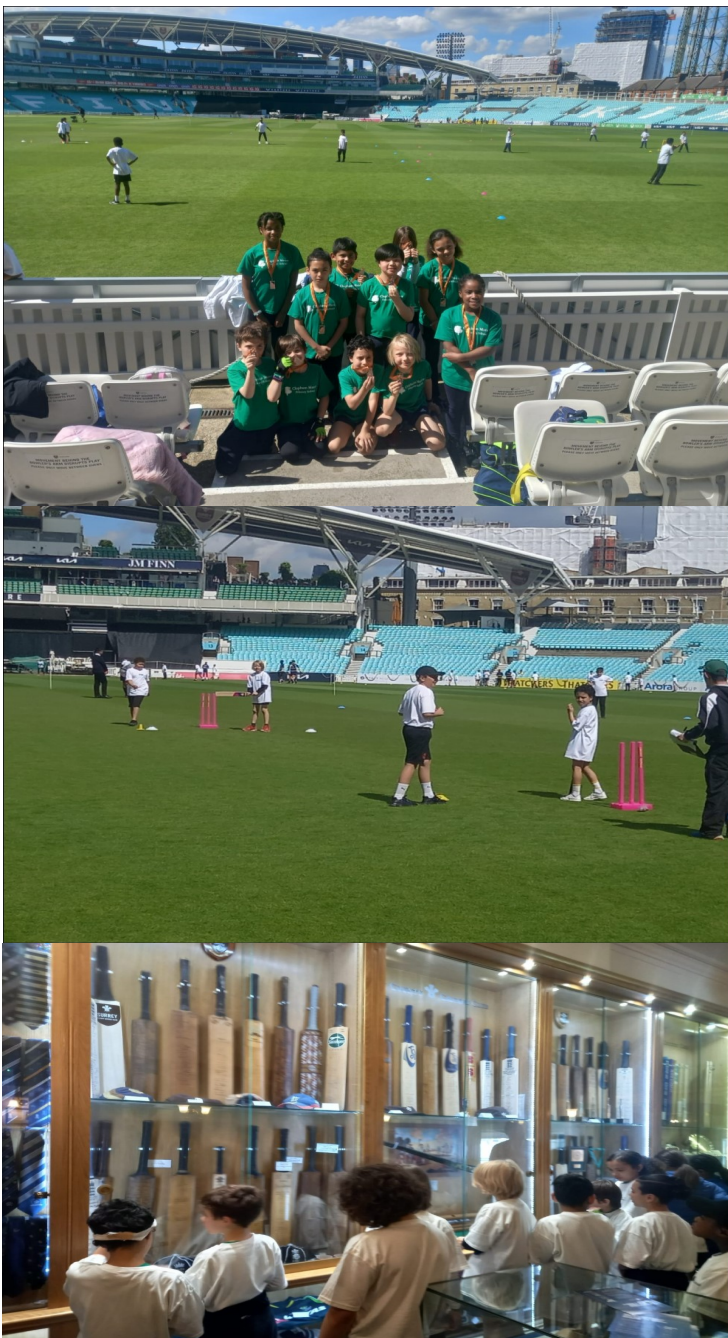


Sporting Success

What brilliant team work Year 4!





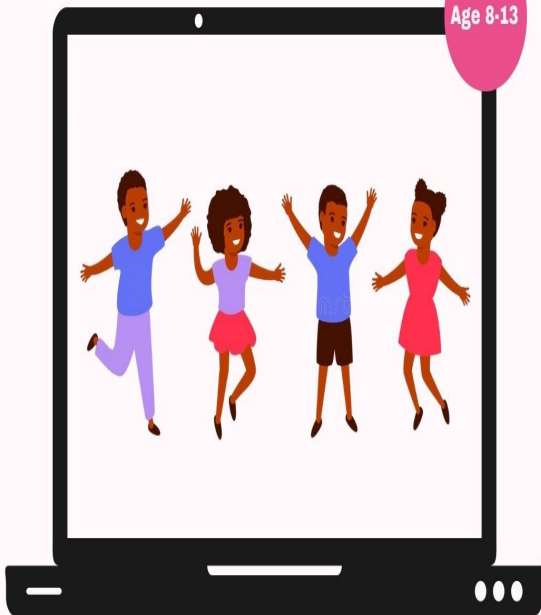

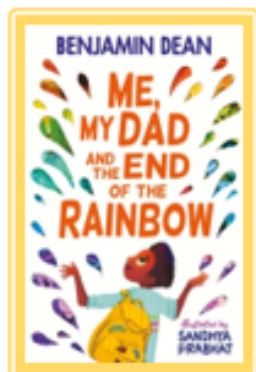
