PLEASE NOTE!

Eligibility for 30 Hours Funding

Deadlines for the 30 hours applications:

- 31st August for Autumn term start (September)
- 31st December for Spring term start (January)
- 31st March for Summer term start (April)
- www.lambeth.gov.uk/freeearlylearning

Reconfirm to remain eligible:

- For 30 hours childcare you must reconfirm every 3 months by the end date
- This must be done even if your child does not start 30 hours until the following term
- Reminders by email from HMRC may occur 4 and 2 weeks before your end date
- Log into your HMRC account and complete the reconfirmation details, press submit
- If you are a foster parent, please contact the Local Authority to reconfirm

Your End Date:

- Get your end date from your provider
- Note it and put a reminder in your diary
- Go into your HMRC secure account and reconfirm **BEFORE** this date
- If you do not reconfirm, your code will become invalid

Grace period:

- Allows you to retain your 30 hours place for a short period when you become ineligible
- During this period your child cannot transfer to another nursery
- You will go back to 15 hours per week after this period
