- ▶ We all learned together this week in our maths lessons. Thank you so much to those of you who came in. We look forward to sharing our science learning with you in Science open classrooms next March!



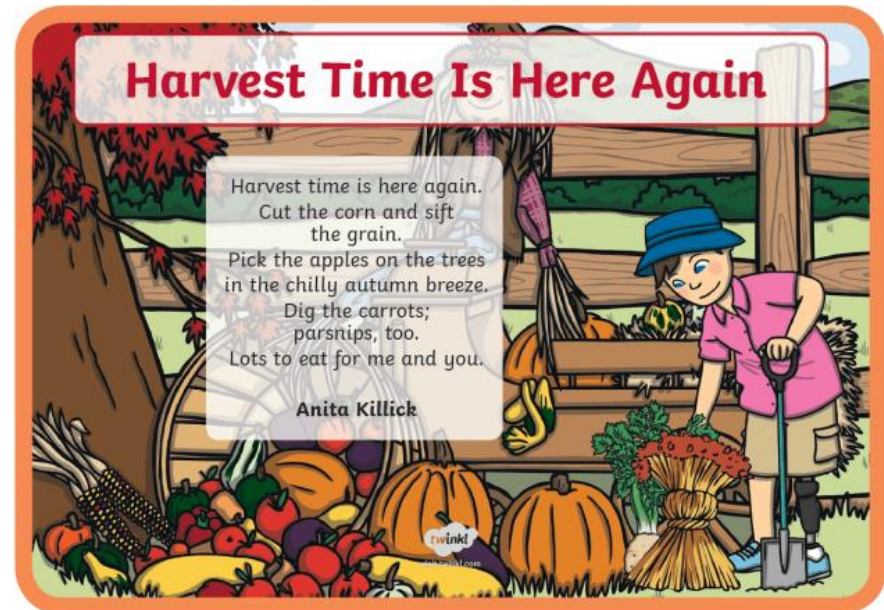


