Finally, we are currently advertising for a Midday Meal Supervisor position, please see further information on the PDF attached.



Please bring along cash (small change!) as we have limited card readers and changes for the stalls.

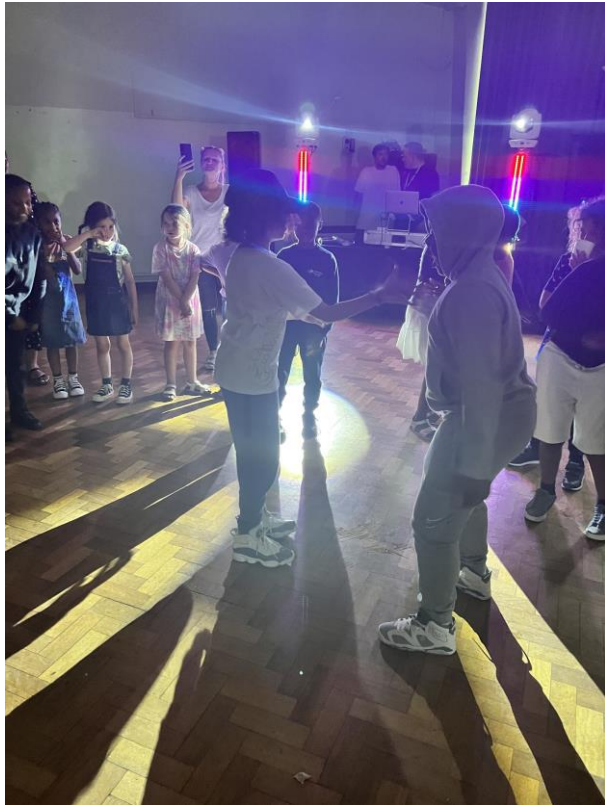
This is an event that brings the whole community together and raises important funds for our wonderful school. All funds raised from the Summer Fair 2023, will also go towards the playground renovations.

As part of the ongoing investment in our library buildings, work has started at Durning Library to restore the room at the front of the building to create a meeting and activity space for the local community. There will be a short closure of the library from 30 June to 7 July 2023 inclusive. Further work later in the year will see a new lift at Brixton, which will give access to the basement and improvements in air conditioning at Streatham Library.

Lambeth Libraries were delighted to be awarded £45,607 to make our library catalogue discoverable via Google and to make it possible to interactively browse the book shelves in our libraries online. This will go live by the end of this year.
