Last week, Year 2 visited the WRWA Recycling Centre in Wandsworth to support our science topic on the environment. We also watched the barges on the River Thames get loaded with rubbish that was sent along the river to a power station to make electricity. 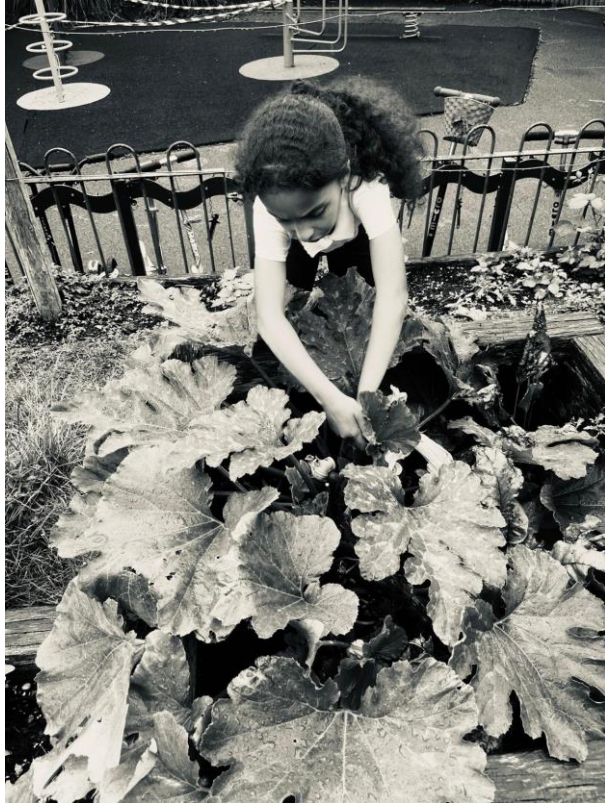




















Year 4 Theatre Workshop

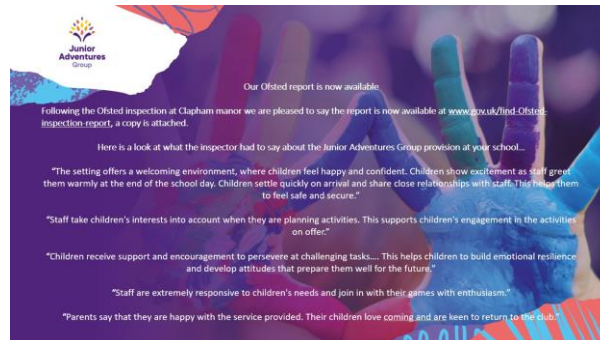


Last but not least. JAG has partnered with a charity to help raise donations for children. In support of Action for Children, we will be doing a fundraiser.
